Your processed data:

We collect core personal data that is necessary to carry out the application, which is: Name, address, gender, phone number. We also collect and process any other data you provide us voluntarily within the course of your application which is e.g. your CV, your cover letter or your picture. If you do not declare your voluntary consent to the further processing of your data in our Talent Pool, your data will only be transferred to the corresponding Human Resource officer and line manager, who is responsible for your application.

Optional information:

Insofar as we ask you for pictures within the framework of the recruitment process, this is done on the basis of a separate declaration of consent, which is voluntary and which you can revoke at any time.

Data deletion:

All data collected by us will be destroyed or deleted as soon as it is no longer needed for the performance of the application - which is in general after six months - or as soon as the employment relationship has been terminated and legal retention periods are no longer contradictory.

Confidential treatment of your data:

Your data will be treated confidentially in any case. We only transfer data to third parties if this is absolutely necessary and there is a legal basis.

If necessary, we may also pass on your data to service providers who support us, for example, in the areas of IT or archiving and destruction and with whom separate contracts for order processing have been arranged.

Furthermore, in individual cases further legal obligations (e. g. requests from authorities) may exist for the transmission of data. These transmissions don't take place in general, but only in specific individual cases.

Your privacy rights:

As a data subject, you have the right to be informed about the personal data concerning you as well as to correct incorrect data. You also have the right to have your data deleted if one of the reasons stated in Article 17 of the GDPR applies, e. g. if the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued. You may delete your account in the account area after logging in with your credentials. You may then click on Applicants -> My Account -> Delete Account.

Furthermore, there is the right to restrict processing if one of the prerequisites specified in Art. 18 GDPR is fulfilled and, in the cases of Art. 20 GDPR, the right to data portability.

Any person affected has the right to appeal to a data protection authority if he or she considers that the processing of the data relating to him or her is in conflict with the data protection legislation. In particular, the right of appeal may be invoked before a data protection authority in the Member State of the person concerned, the place of residence or employment or the place of the suspected infringement.
